Preston and Diane Meyer tally the votes and provide a 3-page document on the winning cars, the year, model and type of vehicle plus the name of the registrant—not an easy task.



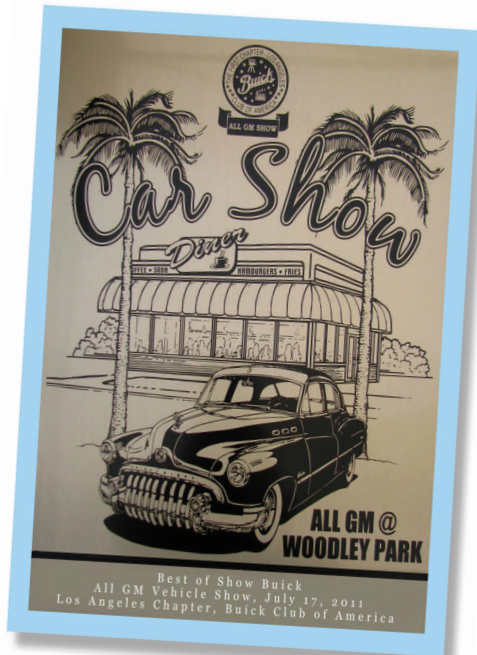

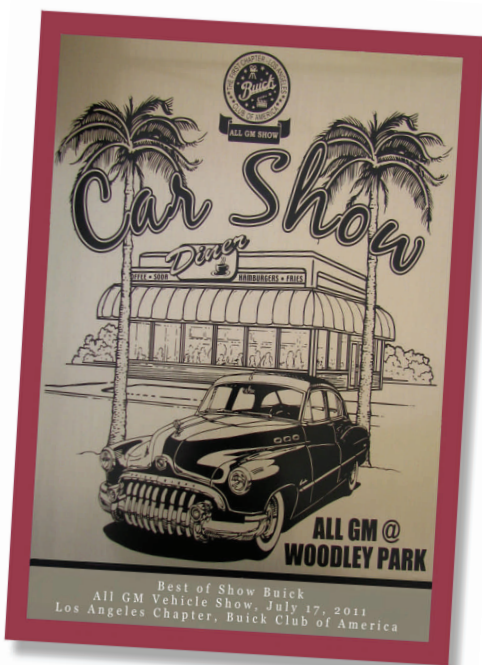

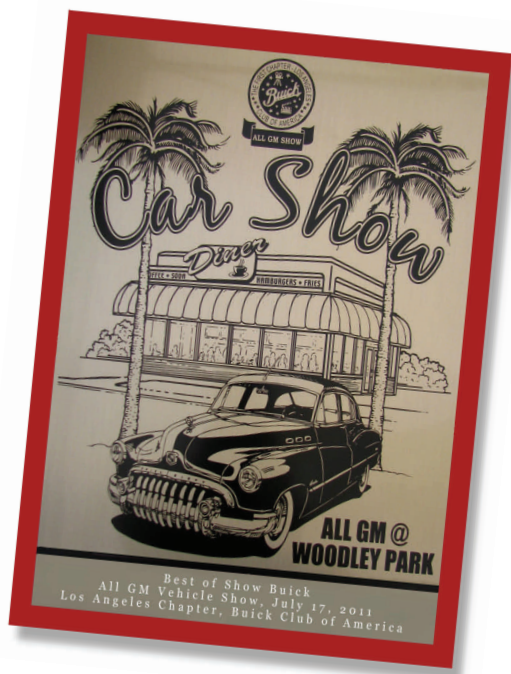
